Pentecostalism & the Church in Canada and *Holy Spirit & the Church* are required courses for PAOC credentials. Students interested in becoming credentialed should take these courses as additional electives.

GDC students are encouraged to audit *Introduction to Spiritual Formation*, which runs as a Winter Semester course, joining for the class dates prior to their trip, and rejoining after returning.
